

Downtown Development Revolving Loan Fund (DD RLF)

The purpose of the Downtown Development Revolving Loan Fund (DD RLF) is to assist cities and counties in implementing quality downtown development projects.

Eligible Applicants are municipalities with populations of 50,000 or less or counties proposing projects in municipalities with populations of 50,000 or less.

Funds were authorized to be used for the DD RLF by the Georgia General Assembly beginning with fiscal year 2000. The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) administers the DD RLF and makes loans to eligible applicants. Eligible applicants may, with DCA approval, loan DD RLF funds to downtown development authorities, for-profit or not-for-profit organizations, or other eligible sub-recipients. DCA staff reviews all loan requests and DCA sets terms for each approved loan application depending on project needs.

The loan limit is \$250,000 per project. At its discretion, DCA may decide to lend an amount less than the amount requested in an application.

Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund (RLF)

The goal of this program is the creation and/or retention of jobs, primarily for low and moderate income persons in the City of Waycross by providing financial assistance to existing businesses and/or “start up” ventures where the City’s involvement is necessary for the projects viability.

This program is designed to assist small service, commercial and industrial businesses in the City of Waycross by providing “gap financing.”

This financial assistance must result in the meeting of the overall program objectives and the creation or retention of permanent jobs for low and moderate income persons.



If you are opening a business that requires licensing by the City of Georgia, the applicant must bring their certificate or card with them before the City of Waycross can process an application for a business license.

- All free-standing signs must be 5 feet off of property line to lead-in edge of sign.
- Size of signs depends on where the business is located and the size of the building.
- Stick in the ground signs are prohibited.

Business signs must meet City of Waycross Zoning Ordinance Section VIII and must pull a permit before installing any signs.

All commercial locations must receive a Fire Prevention inspection before occupancy. If the building has an automatic fire sprinkler system, a fire alarm system or a kitchen hood fire suppression system, then these systems will have to be inspected by a Georgia licensed contractor and a copy of the report submitted to the Fire Marshal for review. The implementation department is responsible for ensuring the location is safe for personnel, customers and others. This process requires an inspection and compilation with city code occupancy issues. The Building Inspector will determine if there are any construction or other permit issues that need to be addressed. Befor selecting a location, check with the Planning and Zoning Department to determine if it meets the zoning requirements. Areas of the city are zoned for Commercial or Industrial use. Occupational taxes are based on the estimated gross receipts except for practitioners listed in O.C.G.A. 48-13-9(c), paragraph 1 through 18. Occupational Tax Registrations last from January 1st to December 31st and must be renewed annually by March 1st. The first time start up fee is \$30.00, each year thereafter is based upon gross receipts of the business. For additional information, please feel free to call (912) 287-2944.
